

Conflict Resolution Week (CRW) Code of Conduct

All attendees, speakers, sponsors, and other participants at our conference are required to agree to follow the CRW Code of Conduct. We expect cooperation from all participants to help ensure a safe environment for everybody.

Harassment is strictly prohibited at CRW and will be enforced accordingly.

Harassment includes: offensive verbal or written comments, actions, images, photography, recordings; deliberate intimidation; stalking; disruption of CRW; inappropriate backgrounds; or unwelcome attention based on, but not limited to, sex, gender identity and expression, age, familial status, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, color, ethnicity, national origin, religion, or veteran status.

Participants asked to stop any harassing behavior are expected to comply immediately.

If a participant engages in harassing behavior or any other disruption of CRW, the conference organizers may take any action they deem appropriate, including warning the offender or expulsion from the conference.
